#### **NOTICE**

Under Section 6 (2) of the Statistics Ordinance, 1961, this form must be completed and returned to the enumerator, or by post to your District Commissioner by midday on 18th August, 1962.

#### HOW TO COMPLETE THE SCHEDULE

- Column 1. Name.—Write name of head of household if at home. If not, write next senior member of family. Then write all other people in house and servants quarters on census night.
- Column 2. Relationship to Head of Household.—If head write "H". If wife write "W". If son write "S". If daughter write "D". If other relative write "R". If servant or lodger or guest write "X".
- Column 3. Sex.—Write "M" or "F".
- Column 4. Age.—Write age last birthday.
- Column 5. Race.—Write European, Arab, Somali or African, etc. Asians must write Indian or Pakistan.
- Column 6. Nationality or Tribe.—For non-Africans state nationality, for Africans state tribe. For British Subjects or British Protected Persons write "British". For others state main nationality, e.g. French, Greek, etc., as written in their passports.
- Column 7. Religion.—For Christians write R.C. or Prot. For others write the main religions, e.g. Hindu, Islam, Sikh, Jew.
- Column 8. Birthplace.—If born in this District write "Here". If born elsewhere in Kenya give the name of the District. If born outside Kenya give the name of the country.
- Column 9. Period of Residence.—Write number of years spent in Kenya since date of first arrival.
- Column 10. Marital Status.—State whether single, married, widowed or divorced, or legally separated.
- Column 11. Education.—Write number of years spent at full-time school. Omit university, night schools, etc.

#### Columns 12 to 14—Men Only

- Column 12. Occupational Status.—If a man runs his own business, write "Own account". If a man works for a wage or salary, write "Employee". If he works without pay in a business owned by another member of his household write "family". If unemployed, write "none". For students write "S", for retired persons write "R", for disabled write "D".
- Column 13. Occupation.—Write here what the man actually does, e.g. clerk, mechanic, painter.
- Column 14. Industry.—This refers to kind of trade, e.g. farming, brewing, retail trade, public service.

#### Columns 15 to 17-Women Only

- Column 15. Total Children Born Alive.—Write the number of all children ever born to the woman whose name is in Column 1. If none write "0".
- Column 16. Number of Children Alive Now.—Includes children now adult or living elsewhere.
- Column 17. Births During 12 Months Preceding Census.—If any, and if child is still alive and present, make sure that the name written in Column 2 and "Under One" in Column 4.
- Housing Particulars. No. of Living Rooms.—Write number of sleeping or living rooms, excluding bathrooms, kitchens, stores and outhouses.

Type of construction refers to walls and not to roof.

In columns 2, 3 and 4 put a tick in the appropriate box.
